**Notes to Hayward Parents:**

1) Please be respectful of your coach. They are trying to do the best they can with large groups of 5 and 6 year olds. They volunteered to step up and help. That alone deserves respect.

2) Coaches love helpers. They will gladly accept someone who will organize snacks for the kids or rake the fields after games.

3) Uniforms are to be handed in at the last game. Hayward Northwest Little League has been trying hard to improve our program. When we have to replace uniforms that go missing, that's money we can't spend on the fields or equipment. We do not want to have to go through the hassle of making parents write out checks for uniform deposits!

**SIDE NOTE\* IF YOU HAVE ANY UNIFORMS IN YOUR HOME FROM PREVIOUS YEARS, PLEASE BRING THEM INTO THE CONCESSION STAND AT ANY OF THE GAMES IN HAYWARD. THIS WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED!**

4) Sign up on time...we never want to turn away a kid that wants to play ball, but when people sign up late it swells the size of our teams to an unmanageable level. We have to make team placement (a figure out how many teams to field at each level) so that we can get going. We make every effort to get the word out...with radio announcements on WRLS and WHSM, in the Sawyer County Record and Sharon will have it posted on the Hayward Sports Center's web-site very early in the year. The school no longer allows us to send home handouts with students, so don't expect your child to be bringing one home. Signing up on time would be a great help to our league running smoothly, but we need your help.
